



IOE Library two-minute tour.

00:00 A photo of the IOE building. IOE Library 2 minute tour.

00:05 Go up the stairs to level 4 of the IOE, and the library is straight ahead.

00:12 Tap your ID card on the barrier to enter the library.

00:14 On your left as you enter is our Help Desk. Our friendly staff are here to help.

00:18 Go through the doors to your right to find print, copy, scan machines (MFDs) and laptop loan lockers.

00:25 Leave the MFD room, pass the Help Desk on your left and turn to the right.

00:28 The central staircase is in front of you and there are collection shelves to your left and before the staircase. The collection in front of the staircase, facing you, is the Literature Collection.

00:37 Walk past the Literature Collection and past the central staircase on your right.

00:38 Shelves containing the Curriculum Resources Collection are on your left and right.

00:43 Turn to your right, walk past the study desks and find the Children's Book Corner ahead.

00:48 Next to the Children's Book Corner, there are bookable rooms.

00:50 Turn around, leave the Children's Book Corner turning left, and walk to the central staircase.

00:54 Walk up the central staircase to level 5.

00:56 Turning to the right, there are study desks on your left and the Main Education Collection on your right.

00:59 Turn 180 degrees and walk past the central staircase on your left.

01:00 The Main Education Collection is on your left, and study desks on your right.

01:01 Reach the end of the collection and turn left.

01:02 Walk along the end stack and on your right you will find the dissertation collection.

01:06 Next to the dissertation collection is a lift.

01:08 Press the button to call the lift.

01:11 Enter the lift and press the button to go down to level 3.

01:12 Leave the lift on level 3 and turn left.

01:13 Turn right and on your left are collection shelves containing the Comparative and International Education Collection.

01:14 Walk straight ahead with the International Education Collection on your left.

01:21 Walk past the central staircase on your right.

01:24 The toilets are on your right.

01:25 Continue walking forwards and on your left is the Non-Education Collection.

01:29 Stopping at the end of the Non-Education Collection, the rolling stacks containing journals are on the right, and an area of open-access desktop PCs in front of you and to the left.

01:31 Turn 180 degrees and walk back the way you came until you reach the central staircase on your left.

01:34 Walk up the central staircase one floor level, to level 4.

01:36 Turn to the right and walk forwards.

01:37 On the left are the self-service machines, to borrow and return items.

01:41 Continue to walk towards the Help Desk.

01:43 At the Help Desk, a friendly member of staff waves goodbye. See you soon.

01:45 Continue past the Help Desk and walk towards the exit.

01:46 Tap your ID card on the barrier to leave the library.

01:48 A photo of the IOE building. See you soon.
